Fund investment policy

The fund aims to achieve low volatility returns in excess of 9% per annum. To achieve this the fund will invest mainly but not exclusively in a range of low volatility debt instruments.

Investments to be included in the Aurora Worldwide Fund, will, apart from assets in liquid form and listed and unlisted financial instruments as allowed by the Act, consist solely of participatory interests of portfolios of schemes registered in the Republic of South Africa or of participatory interests or any other form of participation in portfolios of collective investment schemes or other similar schemes operating in territories with a regulatory environment which is to the satisfaction of the manager and the trustee as being of a sufficient standard to provide investor protection at least equivalent to that in South Africa.

There will be maximum effective equity exposure (including international equity) of up to 50% of the market value of the portfolio

Who this investment may be suitable for

This fund is suitable for investors looking to achieve long term capital growth with a lower volatility profile than the industry average. Investors should not be dependent on regular income distributions from this fund.




Fund manager commentary


During the month the fund was fully invested in local medium term debt and hedge funds. The hedge funds included multiple strategies including local & offshore equities, as well as fixed income & commodities.
